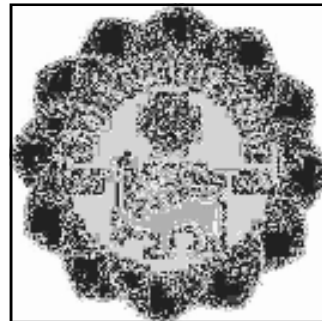

## What is the Lions Eye Health Program LEHP ?

The Lions Eye Health Program is a community-based education program that allows Lions clubs, other community organizations, and individuals to promote healthy vision and raise awareness of the causes of preventable vision loss. The mission of LEHP is to empower communities to save sight through the early detection and timely treatment of glaucoma and diabetic eye disease, encourage those at risk to undergo a dilated eye exam, and educate those with low vision and their caregivers about the condition.

LEHP is the main SightFirst-funded initiative for industrialized nations. LEHP has been active in the United States, Japan, Canada, and several other countries. Everyone interested in eye health can now participate in LEHP and help to increase eye health awareness.

Glaucoma is normal to high eye pressure damaging the optic nerve. There are some medications and treatments to help control this condition.

A Cataract is cloudiness of the natural lens. Worldwide, cataracts are the leading cause of blindness. Cataract surgery is the number one treatment for this eye condition.

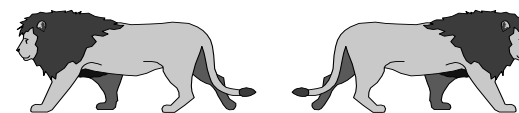
